

ROUTE DESCRIPTION

13A - Oak and County Line via Aetna, Lakewood and Woodlake Village

EASTBOUND - Leaving Metro Center North to Adams St. to 5th Ave. - East on 5th Ave. to Broadway - Leaving 5th & Broadway - east on Route 12/20 to Aetna Ave. - South on Aetna Ave. to 10th Ave. - East on 10th Ave. to Lake St. - North on Lake St. to 4th Ave. East on 4th Ave. to Grand Blvd. - North on Grand Blvd. to Ash Place - East on Ash Place to Montgomery St. - North on Montgomery St. to Hemlock Ave. - East on Hemlock Ave. to Rush St. - North on Rush St. to Lakewood Ave. - East on Lakewood Ave. to Vanderburg St. - North on Vanderburg St. to Pottawatom Trails - East on Pottawatom Trails to County Line Road - North on County Line Road to Oak Avenue (End of the Line)

WESTBOUND - West on Oak Ave. to Shelby St. - South on Shelby St. to Locust Ave. - West on Locust Ave. to Montgomery St. - South on Montgomery St. to Forest Ave. - West on Forest Ave. to Grand Blvd. - South on Grand Blvd to Hemlock Ave. to Lake St. - South on Lake St. to 7th Ave. - West on 7th Ave. to Utah St. - South on Utah St. to Route 12/20 - West on Route 12/20 to 4th Ave. - Enter Metro Center. (End of the Line)

All trips of the Oak & County Line Rd. Route will travel through the Aetna subdivision. Connection to all GPTC routes except 6, and 20.

RULES FOR RIDING THE BUS

1. No smoking on GPTC buses.
2. No radio playing on the bus unless you have headphones.
3. No eating or drinking on GPTC buses.
4. No profanity.
5. Shoes, shirts, and pants (or dresses) are required.
6. Please remain seated while bus is in motion.
7. Please request a stop at least two-thirds of a block before getting off bus by pushing buzzer near window.
8. Exact fare is required. Driver cannot make change.
9. Present I.D. if you are an elderly/ disabled rider.
10. Do not distract driver while bus is in motion.

All passengers are expected to exercise proper conduct on vehicles. GPTC reserves the right to revoke riding privileges of riders who threaten the health or safety of other passengers or the driver.

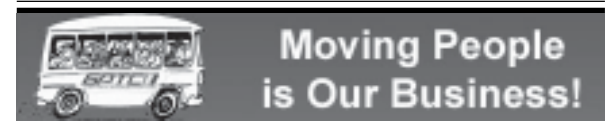
