The Gary Public Transportation Corporation (GPTC) has taken initial precautions to make employees and the public aware of COVID-19. After attending local NISSA meetings, we provided flyers on what Coronavirus is to employees and vendors at our location. We are also in the process of providing each transit bus and department with Disinfecting Wipes to wipe down common areas frequently. We have also advised employees who feel sick or have an onset of any flu-like symptoms to remain home.

Gary Public Transportation Corporation has responded to the CORONAVIRUS or COVID-19 outbreak by enacting the following emergency measures:

- Provided information from WHO (World Health Organization) and The CDC (Center of Disease Control) to its employees at both locations, vendors at 4th avenue and posted preventative measures and symptoms on buses and our managed property.
- GPTC equipped each fleet vehicle operator with pocket hand-sanitizer for personal use and Disinfecting Wipes to periodically sanitize surfaces during routes
- All employees have been advised not to work if any symptoms of the flu occur
- Information has been shared about COVID-19 on our social media pages/accounts and website
- Providing time for extra cleaning of GPTC vehicles while in service

GPTC actively reviews The Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH) on a daily basis to keep employees and communities we serve informed on the latest news regarding COVID-19.
