- For hard copy entries, use pencil, print, marker, crayon, felt pen. If providing a hard copy entry, size should also be 4.25" wide x 11" tall. (Size of a regular sheet of paper folded in half vertically. That's the size you need to draw, sketch and create your design in.)
- By submitting your artwork for this contest you agree to it being used as a crosswalk design, and in media post by GPTC, City of Gary and the Downtown Art, History and Fitness Trail team.
- Designs using blocks of colors, with some gradients, work best for pavement artwork.
